

Grant Application Form

The Alpha Beta Giving Circle (the "Giving Circle") is an annual grant program for Beta undergraduate actives providing financial aid to fund life-enriching experiences based on membership, merit, and need. To be eligible to receive funding, the applicant must be a Miami University undergraduate student in good standing and currently active in the Alpha Chapter of Beta Theta Pi. Undergraduate seniors are eligible if graduation is expected within the current acadmic year. Successful applicants will be required to comply with the requirements of the Miami University Foundation. They will also be asked to submit a follow-up report to the Giving Circle upon completion of the project.

General Instructions:

- Requests should clearly state their relation to the Code of Beta Theta Pi and the Men of Principle. Only
 one proposal per student per year is allowed. Submissions will not be returned. There is no limit on the
 funding size. An undergraduate Beta may submit a proposal in the Giving Circle year for projects occurring
 between May through the end of January of the current acadmic year. Proposals may be funded in whole
 or in part at the discretion of the Giving Circle membership
- · You must fill in all the sections of this application form
- Read the instructions for each section and respond accordingly
- Do not exceed the word limit for a given section.
- We recommend that you compose the verbiage for the application in a word processing program and transfer the contents to this form when you are satisfied with your writing. Use the word processing program to verify that the number of words does not exceed the limit for a given section
